

Volunteer info sheet

Thank you for volunteering your time, you make the lives of our animals better.

Our first priority is your safety, and the safety of our animals so please read this carefully and follow our guidelines.

- When walking dogs on the road you must wear a high visibility jacket. We will supply these on arrival
- If you have any bags or anything you do not wish to carry, you can leave them in the portacabin. Please leave no valuables as we cannot guarantee its safety. There are also toilet facilities in said portacabin.
- Always carry your phone in case you have an emergency. Make sure you have our number in it so you can quickly dial us. Our number is 089 222 2162
- **Never** open any kennels by yourself. Please wait for a member of staff. They will hand you a dog.
 - Don't stick your hands into any enclosures, some of our animals do bite.
 - If you are in a group, make sure the dogs have safe distance between them as not all dogs get along and some may have kennel cough or other issues which we wouldn't like to spread.
 - If you walk in a group, please all walk on **one** side of the road so cars can pass you safely. The road is small so pull in well.
 - Please wash your hands often as this prevents spreading disease also disinfect clothes so you don't take any bugs back to your own pets. Staff can help with this.
 - **Never let a dog off the lead,** this will get us into trouble with our neighbours.
- And don't go into any fields as we don't have permission. Please don't litter.
- If you are walking on the road turn **left** at the bottom of our lane, walk past the graveyard turn right, then turn right again at the T junction, this will bring you around a block, it takes approx 25 to 30 minutes and will lead you up a steepish hill which will join back to the road you started on.
